3. The Objects for which the Company is established are:

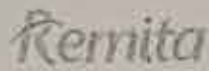
- a) To engage in the business of information and communication technology (ICT) as related to computer service discipline in all its branches and ramification i.e. internet content development, networking, maintenance and servicing of computers and contract, artificial intelligent, software development, systems manufacturing or and assembling, website development and internet services provider (ISP), IT solution providers and computer business services.
- b) To carry on the business of media production in all its ramifications including but not limited to TV production, Radio production, Television/Radio Broadcast, Photography, audio and video production, publishing and printing of newspapers, magazines, journals, books, newsletters, periodicals, or otherwise and to carry out the services of events, indoor and outdoor marketing, branding, packaging of company products and services.
- c) To carry on the business of general contractors, general suppliers, importation, exportation, trading, marketing, sales and distribution of general goods whether manufactured or not, to act as commission agents, manufacturers' representatives and general merchants, may sell, manufacture and deal in general merchandise and all articles, substances, products, systems and appliances that will enable it realize its set objectives.
